**POSITION DESCRIPTION:** Wilberforce University is seeking a Counselor/Health Advisor; reporting to the Dean of Students. This position should work collaboratively with Academic Support personnel and Residence Life personnel to provide appropriate training and workshops for staff and students. The counselor/health advisor participates in the emergency on-call rotation. Must be able to work as part of the overall student development and enrollment management team. This is a Contract position.

**OVERALL RESPONSIBILITIES:** This position is responsible for providing services to students and outreach programming for the University community. Outreach programming to target, but not limited to issues pertaining to women's issues, stress management, conflict resolution, healthy choices and transitions pertaining to living in a residential education community.

**REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATION:** Master's degree required. Certification in counseling and previous experience in collegiate counseling preferred. Commitment to an educational environment, team approach and innovation are essential.
