REHABILITATION COUNSELING FACULTY POSITION

POSITION DESCRIPTION: Tenure-track Assistant Professor of Rehabilitation Counseling to teach at least four graduate courses per semester, reporting to the Director of Graduate Studies. Courses may include Research Methods and Statistics, Assistive Technology, Med/Psych Aspects of Disability, Assessment and Evaluation, Foundation/Rehabilitation Counseling, and/or Theory/Practice of Rehabilitation Counseling. The faculty member also will serve as academic advisor, conduct site visits, supervise practicum and internships and collaborate with site supervisors. Professor will work effectively with a diverse student and faculty population and participate in research and publications.

QUALIFICATIONS: A doctoral degree in Rehabilitation Counseling; ABD will be considered; CRC certification and LPC/LPCC licensure in Ohio preferred; at least 5 years of successful university teaching experience. Demonstrate clear potential for future research leadership in an area related to Rehabilitation Counseling. Salary will be commensurate with experience and qualifications.
